1 Types of Temporary and Tournament Registrations

Approved August 14, 2021

1.1 Tryout Passes

- 1.1.1 The maximum number of games covered by a Tryout Pass is three. (A league may limit this to fewer than three games.)
- 1.1.2 Maximum number of players allowed to play on a team in a given game using a tryout pass is five. (A league may limit this to fewer than five players.)
- 1.1.3 A league may determine a cutoff date for the use of tryout passes during each season.
- 1.1.4 If a league wishes to reduce the numbers allowed under 1.1.1 or 1.1.2 or specify a cutoff date under 1.1.2, the league must provide these league specific rules in writing and provide this to the CSAN Staff in a timely manner.
- 1.1.5 A player may obtain a tryout pass for a given team once per season.
- 1.1.6 CSAN charges \$8 per player for a Tryout Pass.
- 1.1.7 If a player is selected to play for a team based on his or her tryout, the player must purchase a normal player pass in order to continue to play for that team. The player must pay full price for this player pass and it will expire at the same time as all other player passes in that league.
- 1.1.8 An electronic or paper registration verification for a Tryout Pass will be issued to the player or team manager by CSAN staff.

1.2 Short Tournament Pass

- 1.2.1 For use in a tournament that lasts no more than four consecutive days.
- 1.2.2 Maximum number of tournament pass players per team TBD by tournament rules.
- 1.2.3 CSAN charges \$10 per player for a Short Tournament Pass.
- 1.2.4 An electronic or paper registration verification for a Short Tournament Pass will be issued to the player or team manager by CSAN staff.
- 1.2.5 At their discretion, CSAN staff may authorize tournament organizers to sell Short Tournament Passes on behalf of CSAN. CSAN Staff will determine the circumstances and requirements of such activity, if authorized.

1.3 Extended Tournament Pass

- 1.3.1 For use in a tournament whose games are spread over a number of weeks.
- 1.3.2 An extended tournament may involve no more than seven games per team.
- 1.3.3 The maximum number of players on a team using extended tournament passes is determined by the tournament organizers and must be specified in writing.
- 1.3.4 CSAN charges \$15 per player for Extended Tournament passes.

2 ANNUAL USASA TOURNAMENT PASS

- 2.1 CSAN charges \$26 per player for an Annual USASA Tournament Pass.
- 2.2 CSAN will collect the following information from each player who is issued an Annual USASA Tournament Pass:
 - 2.2.1 Last Name
 - 2.2.2 First Name
 - 2.2.3 Player's gender identification
 - 2.2.4 Player's complete mailing address
 - 2.2.5 Telephone Number
 - 2.2.6 Date of Birth
 - 2.2.7 Email Address (if available)
 - 2.2.8 Players Privacy Selections (optional)
- 2.3 A plastic player pass will be issued that expires one year from the purchase date.
- 2.4 The player pass will not show a league or team name but will instead say "For USASA Affiliated Tournament Use Only".
