- 2. Approval of Region I 2024 Winter Meeting Minutes (9 February 2024) The minutes approved as presented by unanimous consent. Minutes already posted on Region web site.
- 3. Treasurer's Report Region I Treasurer Vincent Treglia: Treasury Report sent out and posted. Regional Cup largest expenses for the region. The cup support to be discussed at USASA level. Budget is a calendar year and the Region is on target with what was projected.
- 4. Director's Report Tony Falcone
 - Livio D'Arpino Award: The 2024 recipient is Scott Michael Mapes (VT).
 - Tony discussed the need for increase for Region support in the USASA budget. Previously it was \$40,000 and cut to \$20,000.
 - Discussion of Cup Format

 - Region to continue Werner Fricker Cup (Region event only) after feedback from Peter P. (ENY) & Bill Marth
 - Status O-30, O-40 and O-50 as national events uncertain but after discussion,
 Region members want to continue
 - Women's Amateur to continue as weekend tournament with open registration with possibility of playing on a separate weekend/location
 - Discussion of host location was opened
 - Director's Farewell: Last meeting as director (6 years), two stints as treasurer as well as deputy director. Tony assured us he will continue to be involved with MD Soccer and possibly with Region cups. A round of applause was given in appreciation of Tony's hard work and commitment to the Region and USASA.

 - Deputy Director, Mary Beth Falk Announced she is running for the At-Large NBOD position. Cezar W. (MA) and Peter P. (ENY) urged R1 to support her in the election.

- Kevin A. (MD) announced MD celebrated its 100th Anniversary held 10 August 2024.
- Richard G. submitted a US Soccer ITG Grant for \$200,000 (for an adult tournament for 4 elites men and women's). This is to support and see the Hank Steinbrecher Cup continue and establish a Women's Open Cup. Richard also announced he started his elected position within US Soccer and USASA in 1988 and in 2025 will not seek any elected position.
- Bill M. (EPSL) on behalf of Region and the greater soccer community thanked Tony F. for all his efforts.
